Introduction

In 1915, a group of citizens got together with one goal in mind: to plan and build the first Country Club in Columbia, Missouri. All were in agreement that this city needed a place – a club – which offered a wonderful golfing experience along with a variety of amenities that catered to the individuals and families alike. From this vision came the creation of Columbia Country Club; and in 1921, the Club's original 9 holes of golf were designed by J.M. Watson.

In the 1940's, Columbia CC proved its appeal and cemented itself as the premier course in Mid-Missouri by playing host to legendary PGA Professionals Ben Hogan and Sam Snead, who conducted playing exhibitions on its hallowed grounds.

In 1987, the back nine was designed by Larry Packard and added to the property, transforming CCC into a 6,436 yard, par 71 championship golf course that captivated both the serious and novice golfers alike. The beautiful classic layout boasted tight fairways carved through heavily wooded areas, lightning fast greens, and the Hinkson Creek meandering through the layout. Just two years after expanding, the Columbia Tribune ranked six of CCC's eighteen holes as Top Golf Holes in the area.

In 2012, world-renowned golf course design firm Hurdzan/Fry was awarded the task of a <u>COMPLETE COURSE REDESIGN</u>. The philosophy was to create a visually stunning layout that rewarded great golf shots and offered playability for golfers of all skill levels. The result was a masterful golf course with an emphasis on the Hinkson Creek and its tributaries, a magnificent waterfall, and an overall agronomical marvel. Tour quality golf, championship shot making, player friendly layout, aesthetically pleasing – the ultimate golfing experience.

Dress Code

- Men must wear a shirt with a collar and khaki style pants/shorts (of Bermuda length or a style specifically designed for golf).

- The following are PROHIBITED: Denim of any style or design, t-shirts, cut-offs, short shorts/skirts, and tank tops

GOLF OUTING OVERVIEW

At Columbia Country Club (CCC), golf events are our specialty. We have a long history of welcoming groups and events to our club. Golf packages are available for groups of all sizes. Whether you are planning a small golf outing of up to 40 players or a full field shotgun, allow our experienced hospitality experts to assist you with every detail. Our staff works together for a top quality golf experience every time.

Format considerations are important when blocking space or collecting pricing information. From tee time events to modified shotguns to full field tournaments our club can accommodate most any request.

Tournaments are required to purchase powered golf carts along with their green fees. Equipment rental is available for men and women provided that tournament requests are received by the course within 10 days of the tournament date.

Practice facilities, group lessons and clinics are available for a fee or included in one of the selected golf outing packages. Scoring is included in all packages and other contests such as putting, chipping, or long drive contests may be added on with prior notice. Custom tee prizes, merchandise and certificates are also available to compliment any golf outing.

A **Tournament Contract** will be sent confirming all details including number of players, format, start time, date and any other details determined at that time to hold space. Once the signed Tournament Contract is returned with the full deposit the event is considered definite.

The **non refundable deposit**, which is applied to your total, **is required to reserve your date**. The amount of the deposit is approximately 10% of the total estimated event total.

Final Count Guarantee. CCC requires that the Tournament Contact confirm the actual number of players in the tournament and actual number of meals, ten (10) days prior to the tournament date. This policy allows CCC the opportunity to sell unused tee times to the general public or another outing. If you fail to notify us of the confirmation number ten (10) days prior to the Tournament Date, the number of players identified as "Number of Players" on the face of this agreement will be deemed the final count. The Tournament Contact will be required to pay for all tee times reserved based upon the final count regardless if they are filled with outing participants or not.

All food and beverage must be provided by the club, unless otherwise arranged with our Tournament Director. We offer a variety of menu selections and packages designed to accommodate any event or request.

Final details are due thirty (30) days prior to your event. Menu pricing can be guaranteed up to ninety (90) days prior to your event. After you provide us with the final selections and arrangements, we will present you with an Event Order confirming the specific requirements of your event. A 20% Service Charge and 7.975% sales tax will be added to all food and beverage items.

Important Deadlines

- 7 days after contract is received deposit is due with a signed Tournament Contract.
- 30-45 days prior to your event meet with the club Tournament Coordinator to discuss details
- 10 days prior to your event guaranteed player count and guaranteed meal count
- 3 days prior to your event pairing list due
- Day of the event Sit back, relax, and enjoy as your hard work pays off with a wonderful day!

GOLF OUTING PACKAGES

Monday Shotgun Events

8:00 AM and/or 1:30 PM Shotgun Starts Available

Non Monday Outings to be arranged by Tournament Director w/ additional fees

All Shotgun Events Consist of

- 18 Holes of golf with a cart; Range balls accessible up to 1 hr. prior to play
- Personalized Cart Signs, Scorecards, Rules Sheets and Scoreboard
- Contest signs to be placed on the golf course
- Professional staff available for scoring, posting and event assistance

A PGA Instructor will be available for personalized attention to any guest inquiring about swing assistance. One Hour prior until Shotgun Start (call for pricing)

Any Shotgun consisting of more than 112 Players will require the course to order additional carts for use by staff, players, and volunteers at an additional cost.

Fields consisting of over 144 Players shall consider a Double-Shotgun format with an 8:00a.m./1:30p.m. start times to avoid congestion, slow play, and renting of additional carts

Occasionally the club may allow smaller group outings on other weekdays other than a Monday during off-peak times based on the following criteria:

- Maximum of 40 players
- Columbia Country Club Management & Board of Directors Approval
- Flexibility of a Modified Shotgun/Tee Time Format in order to minimize the number of tee times blocked off for our Membership.

Confirmation & Booking

The number of players listed on the contract is the number of players that has been approved for the event. We consider a date booked when we have a signed contract and a deposit for the event.

Changes

If it becomes necessary to make a change of more than 10% in terms of guaranteed number of players, or a group would drop below a required number of players for a shotgun minimum, the contract would have to be re-submitted.

Cancellations

If you cancel your event with less than 30 days prior notice you agree to pay a cancellation fee equal to 50% of the amount due under this Agreement, less any Initial Deposits or Pre Payments already received by us. If you cancel your event with less than 10 days prior notice you agree to pay a cancellation fee equal to 100% of the amount due under this Agreement, less any Initial Deposits and Pre Payments already received by us. Cancellation fees are due and owing on the day you cancel your event.

Pairings

Tournament Pairings are necessary to properly prepare cart signs, scorecards, scoreboard etc. A draft copy of the pairings list is requested at least three days before the event. Changes are expected but we request a final list the day before your event. Any changes on the day of the event in the groupings, cart cards or score cards are made on the fly to the best of our ability. We will be unable to re-print scorecards and cart signs on the day of your event.

Signage

Columbia Country Club will NOT distribute hole signs on the golf course for the event unless previously arranged with the Tournament Chair. All signage should be taken from the property on the evening of the event and Columbia Country Club accepts no responsibility for signage left at the property.

Rainouts

In the event the Superintendent for Columbia Country Club closes the Golf Course for any reason, an attempt to reschedule the event will be the first course of action. If by chance the event cannot be rescheduled, the following rates will apply:

3 or less holes completed — Green fee/ Cart fees waived 4 to 7 holes completed — 50 % of the Green fee / Cart fee will be charged 8 or more holes completed — 100 % of the Green fee / Cart fee will be charged

In the event of a rainout where Food & Beverage function space has been booked all scheduled Food & Beverage and non-golf events will be prepared for, staged and charged per the contract.

Our Superintendent will try and make a decision regarding golf course playability, & delays at least 2 hours before your event. Conditions will be monitored throughout the day and any updates will be communicated to the Tournament Director.

Please note that the golf courses will never be closed based on the "weather forecast" alone. Should the Event Chairperson elect to cancel an event for any reason while the facility is open & course conditions are deemed playable, all contracted fees, charges & guarantees will apply.

Food & Beverage

On Course:

Stations are NOT allowed unless approved by Columbia Country Club's Food & Beverage Department with the assurance that a volunteer will be available to monitor the station.

Donated Beverages

Donated Beverage can only be used on the course with the following rules in effect:

- Corkage Fee per player to bring donated beverage onto the property.
- Beverages that have been iced down cannot be re-packaged and/or returned to the group.
- Groups must take any un-opened packaged beverage with them on the night of the event.
- Delivered by a licensed distributor at least one (1) day but no more than four (4) days prior.

We will provide one beverage cart for up to the first 72 guests. Beyond that another beverage cart may be added at the discretion of Columbia Country Club management. An additional fee will be charged for any groups under 72 players that request a second beverage cart.

We provide drivers for the beverage cart. A member of your group can ride along with our driver to help advertise a product or service.

If you do not have donated beverages we will stock and sell our items on the beverage cart to meet your tournament participants needs. Options range from bottled sodas, gatorades, and water, to canned beers and assorted liquor. Please inquire on pricing.

*Drink tickets can be purchased and price is subject to change depending on what items are determined for purchase with them.

PRE/POST Event Room Availability

All Food & Beverage Service for Golf outings will occur in our Fireside Bar & Grill/Patio area. Use of the Grand Ballroom will be granted for a rental fee assuming it is available for the requested time. Main Bar service to the Ballroom may be included for an additional minimum expenditure.

Additional Food & Beverage Selections

It is our goal at Columbia Country Club to work with each event and specifically cater to their needs for a successful event. Additional menu options are available at your request through our catering department and our Food & Beverage Manager would be happy to coordinate F&B selections to fit a specific budget or theme in order to best showcase the event.
