

#### Dress Code

- Men: collared shirt and khaki-style pants/shorts of bermuda length or a style specifically designed for golf
- Women: golf-style shirt and khaki-style pants, shorts or skirts of bermuda length or a style specifically designed for golf
- Soft spikes only
- <u>PROHIBITED:</u> denim of any style or design, t-shirts, cut-offs, short shorts/skirts and tank tops

# 2025 Golf Event Pricing

#### Tournament Pricing: \$75/Player

- 8am or 1:30pm Shotgun Start on a Monday
- 18 Holes with a Golf Cart
- Range balls and access 1 hour prior to play
- Personalized Cart Signs, Scorecards, Rules Sheets & Scoreboard
- Contest/Hole Sponsor sign placement on course
- Professional scoring, score posting and event assistance
- Digital Hole Sponsorships on the GPS Cart Screens (\*see sizing guide)
- \* To Note: Fields consisting of more than 120 players shall consider a Double-Shotgun format to avoid congestion, slow play and additional cart rental





#### **Additional Costs**

- A \$250 Corkage Fee will be assessed for all donated food and/or beverage products
- Fields consisting of more than 120 Players will require additional carts at \$50/cart

- CCC Management & Board of Directors approval
- Requires flexibility of a Modified Shotgun/Tee Time Format in order to minimize Membership Impact

# **Booking Your Event**

#### Step 1: Tournament Contract

- Tournament Contact
- Number of Players
- Format
- Start Time
- Date
- Any other important details

#### Step 2: Non-Refundable Deposit

- Due within 7 Days of Signed Contract
- 10% of Estimated Event Total
- Applied to Final Balance
- Required to Reserve your Date

#### Step 3: Final Count Guarantee

CCC requires that the Tournament Contact confirm the actual number of players in the tournament and actual number of meals, ten (10) days prior to the tournament date.

This policy allows CCC the opportunity to sell unused tee times to the general public or another outing. If the Tournament Contact fails to notify us of the confirmation number ten (10) days prior to the Tournament Date, the number of players identified as "Number of Players" on the face of this agreement will be deemed the final count.

The Tournament Contact will be required to pay for all tee times reserved based upon the final count regardless if they are filled with outing participants or not.



#### **Tournament Timeline**

30-45 Days Prior: Meet with CCC to discuss details

10 Days Prior: Guaranteed Player & Meal Count Due

3 Days Prior: Event Pairings Due

Day of Event: Sit back, relax and enjoy!

#### Confirmation & Booking

The number of players listed on the contract is the number of players that has been approved for the event. We consider a date booked when we have <u>a signed contract and</u> a deposit for the event.

If it becomes necessary to make a change of more than 10% in terms of guaranteed number of players, or a group would drop below a required number of players for a shotgun minimum, the contract would have to be re-submitted.

### Additional Details

#### Cancellations

<u>Less Than 30 Days</u>: You agree to pay a cancellation fee equal to 50% of the amount due under this Agreement, less any Initial Deposits or Pre Payments already received by us.

Less Than 10 Days: You agree to pay a cancellation fee equal to 100% of the amount due under this Agreement, less any Initial Deposits and Pre Payments already received by us.

Cancellation fees are due on the day you cancel your event.

#### **Pairings**

Tournament Pairings are necessary to properly prepare cart signs, scorecards, scoreboard, etc.

At Least 7 Days Prior: Draft copy of the pairings list is requested.

1 Day Prior: Final copy of the pairings is due.

Any changes made on the day of the event to the groupings, cart cards or scorecards will be adjusted to the best of our ability. We will be unable to re-print scorecards and cart signs on the day of your event.

#### Rainouts

The Columbia Country Club Superintendent will try and make a decision regarding golf course playability, & delays at least 2 hours before your event. Conditions will be monitored throughout the day and any updates will be communicated to the Tournament Contact.

In the event the Superintendent closes the Golf Course for any reason, an attempt to reschedule the event will be the first course of action. If by chance the event cannot be rescheduled, the following rates will apply:

<u>3 or Less Holes Completed:</u> Green Fees and Cart Fees Waived, Rain Check/Gift Passes

<u>4-8 Holes Completed:</u> 50% of Green Fees and Cart Fees Charged

9+ Holes Completed: 100% of Green Fees and Cart Fees Charged

Please note that the golf courses will never be closed based on the "weather forecast" alone. Should the Tournament Contact elect to cancel an event for any reason while the facility is open and course conditions are deemed playable, all contracted fees, charges and guarantees will apply.

#### <u>Signage</u>

Columbia Country Club will distribute hole signs on the golf course for the event <u>IF</u> previously arranged with the Tournament Director. All signage should be removed from the property at the conclusion of the event. Columbia Country Club accepts no responsibility for signage left at the property.

## Food & Beverage

#### On Course:

On-course stations are NOT allowed unless approved by CCC's Food & Beverage Department with the assurance that a volunteer will be available to monitor the station.

#### **Donated Beverages**

Donated beverages can only be used on the course with the following rules in effect:

- · Corkage Fee is \$250 to bring donated beverage onto the property.
- Beverages that have been iced down cannot be re-packaged and/or returned to the group.
- · Groups must take any un-opened packaged beverages with them following the conclusion of the event.
- Delivered by a licensed distributor at least one (1) day but no more than four (4) days prior.

We will provide one beverage cart for up to the first 100 guests. Beyond that, another beverage cart may be added at the discretion of CCC management. An additional fee will be charged for any groups under 72 players that request a second beverage cart. We provide drivers for the beverage cart. A member of your group can ride along with our driver to help advertise a product or service, but is restricted from operating the vehicle.

If you do not have donated beverages we will stock and sell our items on the beverage cart to meet your tournament participants' needs. Options range from bottled sodas, gatorades, and water, to canned beers and assorted liquor. Please inquire on pricing.

\*Drink tickets can be purchased and price is subject to change depending on what items are selected.

#### **Event Room Availability**

All Food & Beverage Service for Golf outings will occur in our Fireside Bar & Grill/19th Hole Patio area.

Use of the Grand Ballroom will be granted for events, assuming it is available, with a rental fee of \$500.00. Main Bar service to the Ballroom may be included for an additional \$100.00 minimum expenditure.

#### **Additional Selections**

It is our goal at Columbia Country Club to work with each event and specifically cater to their needs. Additional menu options are available at your request through our Catering Department and our Food & Beverage Manager would be happy to coordinate selections to fit a specific budget, or theme, in order to best showcase the event.



## Lunch & Dinner Buffets

40 PERSON MINIMUM ON ALL BUFFETS

#### Smoked Meats: \$19.95

Brisket, Chicken, and Pulled Pork. Served with baked beans, pasta salad, and potato salad. Fresh mixed greens with your choice of two dressings. Assorted breads and condiments.

#### Off the Grill: \$16.95

Certified angus hamburgers, grilled marinated chicken breasts, and quarter pound all-beef hot dogs. Served with pasta and potato salad, kettle chips and assorted breads, condiments, and garnishes.



#### Nacho Bar: \$15.95

Grilled spiced chicken and ground beef served with tortilla chips, soft tortillas, and house made queso. Top off your meal with chopped tomatoes, sliced black olives, scallions, sour cream, shredded cheese, salsa, and guacamole.

#### The Sandwich Board: \$13.95

Sliced smoked turkey, pit ham, wheatberry bread, buttery croissants, condiments and garnishes, potato chips, pasta salad, and potato salad.
